Keeping Minnesota Ready through Severe Weather Awareness Week

As part of [Severe Weather Awareness Week](#), Stevens County will be participating in tornado drills on Thursday, April 24, at 1:45 p.m. and again at 6:55 p.m. If severe weather occurs on Thursday, Stevens County will cancel and reschedule the drill. The campus will participate in the 1:45 p.m. drill. As part of the test the **Tone Alert Radios** will be activated, there will be a tone followed by a message regarding the test. At that time, the offices with the Tone Alert Radios will activate the calling tree notification system. They should call offices/areas identified on their calling list and inform them of the test, and if it were an actual emergency, they would need to take precautions. Classes will not be interrupted for this test. Tone Alert Radio locations are responsible for placing notification signs on building entrances at the time of the test and not before. At the time of the test, individuals are asked to be aware

of their surroundings and to think about the nearest safe place to go to seek refuge at the time of a potential severe weather or tornado.
