SUMMER SPOTLIGHT

Summer Financial Aid

There is no summer financial aid application. Eligibility is based on the 2020-2021 FAFSA and summer credits. Students should register by **June 7** to maximize financial aid.

Taking six or more credits is not necessarily required to get financial aid during the summer, and does not guarantee a student will receive aid. Eligibility varies depending on the student and the type of financial aid.

The American Indian Tuition Waiver is available during the summer, but many other aid programs are not, so we recommend talking with a One Stop Counselor to get an estimate of summer financial aid eligibility

TIMELY TOPICS FOR SUMMER

- View summer course offerings [here](#).
- All students are charged the \$474/credit resident tuition rate for summer courses. Most courses have \$45/credit online learning fee.
- The payment plan is not available during summer.
- Don't see the courses you need? Consider taking summer courses at [another UMN campus](#) to stay on track for four-year graduation, explore academics, or gain class schedule flexibility.
- You can view summer job postings online. For eligibility questions contact One Stop.
- Summer housing is \$77/week. You can [apply online](#) or email housing2@morris.umn.edu for information.
- Feeling sick? During summer, eligible students can obtain a voucher from ORL or Public Safety for clinic or urgent care visits at SCMC.
- Coverage for students enrolled in the University's Student Health Benefit Plan for spring continues until fall coverage begins in August.
- The [SAGE Grant](#) is available during the summer for students facing short-term financial emergencies.
- The University is finalizing their distribution plan for the second CARES Act payments to students. Students will receive additional information in the coming weeks.
