2) Chancellor Jacquie Johnson

- Inauguration of President Kahler went well
  - Very different than President Bruinicks
  - Focused on Metrics, we need to heed this as a campus.
  - The metrics are important and we need to find a way to convey how Morris is special and unique using metric polls.
- Our campus has a 50% retention/graduation rate for 4 years
  - We'd like to have it up to 60%
  - 5 year is at 75%
  - 6 year is at 80%
  - Our retention from freshman to sophomore year is 83% (UMTC is 90%)
- We need to have more accountability on what students do after graduation
  - The Liberal Arts education creates graduates that have the best critical thinking and problem solving skills. They can be flexible as to what jobs they get and maintain.
  - President Kahler really grasps the importance of the Liberal Arts
- As a campus, there needs to be more upward mobility for staff/faculty (non-tenure track)
  - Create roles that allow for promotion to aid with turnover and enhance staff development.
  - More titles/positions
- Chancellor Johnson's 360 Review is finally finished.
  - Vice Chancellor Sandy Olson-Loy is up for Review next
  - Reviews help air grievances and help those under review improve how they do their jobs.
