*Summary: Charlie Albright will perform on Saturday, October 11.*

(September 26, 2014)-The 2014–15 University of Minnesota, Morris Performing Arts Series continues with classical pianist Charlie Albright on Saturday, October 11. Albright will perform at 7:30 p.m. in the Humanities Fine Arts (HFA) Recital Hall.

Albright is an award-winning and critically acclaimed classical pianist, described by the Washington Post as “among the most gifted musicians of his generation.” He is a frequent collaborator with Yo-Yo Ma and is an official Steinway Artist. Albright’s most recent awards include the 2014 Avery Fisher Career Grant, a 2014 Ruhr Festival Young Artist Scholarship Prize, and the 2010 Gilmore Young Artist award.

Albright also will lead a master class on Sunday, October 12, 10:30 a.m.–12 p.m. in the HFA Recital Hall. All are welcome to come watch and learn from Albright as he works with talented Morris piano students. This event is free and open to the public.
