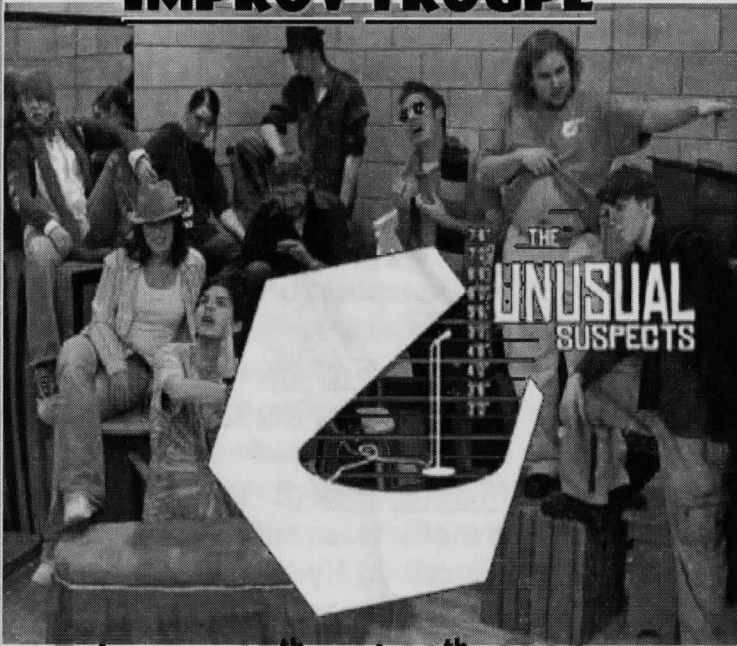

Black Box Theatre

Games

New Choice: Scene is played, but actor must change their last line when leader claps

Chain, Death, Murder: Actors must figure out who died, where they died, and how they were killed while only speaking gibberish

Genres: Scene is played and then replayed in various styles of media

Guess Who's Coming to Dinner: One person hosts a party where they must guess who their guests are

Exaggeration: Three people act out a scene, at any time they may have to 'Make It Bigger'

Foreign Film Dub: A scene is played by two actors who speak a different language while two others translate

Quotes: Scene is played where actors must use lines written by the audience at random times throughout the scene

Stand, Sit, Lie: Actors must stand, sit, or lie during a scene, when one sits they all trade positions

Movie Critic: Three actors recreate a movie named by the audience and described by the 'host'

Countdown: A scene is played and then played again with progressively less and less time

Good Cop, Bad Cop: A person what crime they have committed based on the questions asked by the Good Cop and the Bad Cop

Slide Show: View a slide show told by a person describing the random poses made by three others

Superheroes: A crisis determined by the audience must be solved by four abnormal superheroes

Dating Game: An actor must decide from three dates that they must guess by asking them questions

Forward/Reverse: At anytime the leader may yell 'forward' or 'reverse' at which time the scene must go forward or back in time

Bermuda Triangle: 3 actors get 3 props and make up 3 characters that stick with that prop

Playground Insults: Two 'kids' call each other names with the help of their 'imaginary friends' that can only mime clues

Moving People: The only way that the two people in this scene can move is with assistance

Survivor: Scene starts with 4-5 people and slowly the audience votes people out of the scene

Bus Stop: Try to get the person waiting for the bus to leave
