Fall 2018:

- A. Executed Fall Professional Development Day (FPDD) 2018
 - Pre-registration, packets and facilities preparation
 - Solicited and reviewed feedback from attendees

 - Planned Fall visits -- oversaw scheduling for individual consultations, classroom observations and student feedback through consensus
