MORRIS CAMPUS ASSEMBLY
February 14, 1972

Minutes

Provost Imholte began the Assembly meeting by stating that the motion as amended from the Morris Campus Planning Committee was on the floor.

Ellen Ordway moved to divide the question by considering numbers 1 and 5 of the recommendations and then items 2, 3, and 6. The motion passed, the question was divided, and discussion continued on items 1 and 5.

John Diehl moved to amend item 1 to read:

"The University of Minnesota, Morris Campus should be permitted to grow beyond 2,000 students provided this Assembly approves some plan of growth at some future date."

The motion was seconded and passed by vote.

Harold Hinds then offered a substitute motion as follows:

"Be it resolved that the Campus Assembly postpone final voting on the Growth Proposal until solicitation, preparation, and completion of an academic mission statement for UMM."

Seconded by C. Tatum.

The first vote on the substitute motion ended in a tie. The Chair ruled the tie would stand as a defeat unless countered by a vote to support this decision. That vote gave such support 41 to 28 with 6 abstaining. The substitute motion was defeated and the main motion as divided passed 41 to 34. Items 1 and 5 were approved.

Items 2, 3, and 6 from the Morris Campus Planning Committee were then on the floor.

John Diehl moved the following:

"Be it resolved that the Campus Assembly postpone final voting on the Cluster College Proposal until solicitation, preparation, and completion of an academic mission statement for UMM."

This substitute motion passed 38 to 26 with 2 abstentions.

The Assembly then adjourned.
