A. Meeting was called to order at 11:40am

B. Old Business:

- a. Proposed members for 2019-2020 Student Behavior Committee, including students, faculty, and staff was presented and approved by Brian Nell, seconded by Sydney Loechler and approved by all members.
- b. Dave Israels - Swenson reported that the Student Activities Office adopted a new policy regarding Partisan Student Group Funding. Student groups have been informed of the updated policy. SAC endorsed this policy
- c. The committee reviewed and gave feedback on the Proposed Campus Inclusivity Initiatives which includes Poster Policy Practices and Morris Let's Thrive murals in the Science tunnel. The committee endorses a change to the tunnel, which will continue to evolve and develop a more inclusive look tied to the themes of Morris Let's Thrive.
- d. Mitch Primus made a motion, Sydney Loechler seconded to accept the two New Student Organizations and the Reactivated Student Organization below. All members approved.
 - i. Knitting and Crocheting Club: The purpose of this organization shall be to allow all students the opportunity to knit or crochet with their peers. This group will allow students to express their creativity and share that creativity with others at UMM. - Independent Student Group
 - ii. Running and Walking Club: The purpose of this organization shall be to allow all students the opportunity to exercise by running or walking while socializing with fellow students. - Independent Student Group

- iii. Reactivated Student Organizations - Anonymous Dance Company: The purpose of this organization shall be to give students a way to express themselves, meet new people, and be who they are without judgement through dance. - Independent Student Group
