The minutes for February 7, 14, and 21, 1972, were placed before the Assembly for approval. Lois Bursack amended the February 14 minutes as follows:

Strike the word substitute referring to motions made by Harold Hinds and John Diehl.

The replacement of Donald Wilson by Ardath Larson on the Financial Aids Committee was announced for information.

A report on the Assembly resolution regarding campus autonomy was presented by Provost Imholte. Presently autonomy in grading will become a campus privilege as such a grading resolution is coming before the Senate on March 9, 1972.

The Intercollegiate Athletic Committee introduced the following motion for action:

Proposed that the University of Minnesota, Morris, join the Minn-Kota Women's Intercollegiate Sports Conference.

Discussion of the motion focused upon concerns of additional costs requested of the student Incidental Fee, but it was stated that no additional funds other than those presently used would be necessary to implement the program.

Chuck Tatum moved to table the motion until after the campus forum on intercollegiate athletics is held. The motion failed 33 to 25 with 6 abstentions.

Questions then were directed to the Intercollegiate Athletic Committee concerning its role in adding new sports. It was stated that this committee has added new sports for scheduling after working out the financial feasibility of such additions. It has not come to the Assembly for approval of such changes in the intercollegiate athletic program.

Bert Ahern moved to amend the motion for application to the Minn-Kota Conference as an associate member rather than as a full member. The motion failed by voice vote.

The original motion passed by voice vote.
