Meeting was called to order at 11:41 am. Viktor invited liz and Rob to present an update on the Public Safety Advisory and Dialogue Committee.

liz shared with SAC a [document](#) indicating previous PSADC meeting and tasks accomplished. They discussed the difficulty in securing more student members for PSADC, citing possible lack of clarity in the committee's mission. liz and Rob have done outreach and will continue to do so in the spring. Viktor mentioned the possibility of students serving on SAC to serve on PSADC as well, as the two committees currently have no members in common.

Simon asked about the process by which PSADC was created, the decision to establish it as a subcommittee of SAC, its charge and the ideal number of committee members. Rob referred SAC to information presented at a previous meeting of SAC, and cited 6 students and a total of 8-10 members as a target number.

SAC voted to approve a new student organization, the Plant-Based Club (5 for, 0 against, 0 abstentions)

SAC voted to approve the [minutes from 11/9/2021](#) (5 for, 0 against, 0 abstentions)

Viktor mentioned that the document on Student Organization Creation and Classification will come to Campus Assembly on November 30. He volunteered to present the document and field questions. Simon that Dave Israels-Swenson will be at Assembly to answer questions.
