Meeting was called to order at 11:43am

Guest TJ Ross, Secretary of the Student Behavior Committee brought forward changes to the committee membership for approval. TJ Ross reviewed the current members, their appointment length and role on the committee and asked for approval of 3 new students. There are currently only 3 students with the intent to identify an additional 2 for the committee. All members of the Student Affairs committee approved the student names.

TJ Ross briefed the committee on policy updates to the Student Conduct Code violations and allowed for discussion. These updates match with changes in the Conduct Code and are mostly language changes, no substantive changes. Terms have been updated from "sanction" to "outcome", use of more gender neutral language, all consistent with the system wide updates. TJ Ross reported that specifically in the Morris procedural document is the sexual misconduct information was removed as this is now a EOAA process now, not Student Behavior committee process. This change went into effect system wide in early 2021.

No formal objections to any of the documents were raised in the meeting. The committee members can submit additional feedback, if any, to TJ Ross by October 21, 2022.

Minutes from the September 20, 2022 meeting were approved by all members.

Simon Franco presented a motion to approve 3 new student organizations. Men's Volleyball, NAfME, and NG Club. The committee discussed and Siobhan Bremer called for a vote. All committee members approved the 3 new organizations.

The committee continued discussion of "fun spaces"/providing a vital campus community initiative taken up by the Planning committee. The Campus Activities Council is also meeting with students to brainstorm this issue to look at in more detail. Viktor will invite a representative from the Planning committee to discuss with SAC in more detail what they want this committee to think about and how it can offer the most support.
