1. Minutes #7 from Jan 25th were approved.
2. Mark Fohl, Athletic Director, asked the committee to approve academic athletic eligibility standards for UMM. UMM is in the process of moving from Division II to Division III. In Division II, academic eligibility is dictated by NCAA. In Division III, eligibility is based on the academic standards of the home institution. After extensive discussion, the committee came to a consensus on a general policy. They agreed to edit the wording of the policy during the week and vote on the final version on 2/8/07 before sending the policy to the Assembly. The final version of the policy will be in the minutes for 2/8/07.
3. 3. There was a discussion of a number of reports that the Secretary has been working on. These included information on how Conditional Admits, International Students and Transfer Students did academically fall 06. The committee was also given a summary report of Academic Alert, the fall Probation Workshops and a multiyear probation study.
