STUDENTS NEED A BROADER RANGE OF SKILLS WORK TO BE MORE SUCCESSFUL IN THE HEAVY READING LOAD THEY ENCOUNTER AT THE UNIVERSITY LEVEL IN A SECOND LANGUAGE. Old: PROVISIONALLY APPROVED COURSE SEEKING REGULAR APPROVAL. COURSES FORMERLY TAUGHT IN EDUCATION FOR NON-NATIVE SPEAKERS OF ENGLISH ARE MOVING TO HUMANITIES (WITH A NEW DESIGNATOR) AND THE COURSE OFFERINGS ARE BEING EXPANDED TO MEET THE NEEDS OF OUR INCREASING ENROLLMENT OF NON-NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS.
