### B. Student Services Update

For the UMM Cinema, Communications and Marketing/Ryan Schamp will start taking guest lectures and uploading them onto UMM Cinema, it might be good idea to draft a resolution to codify the process. These lectures can be university filmed or student filmed. Another thing is the Twin Cities Bias and Hate Crime Reporting Network which Student Services is working on implementing here and coming up with ideas of what it would look like. Additionally, the cross walk behind the library has poor lighting and multiple people have been hit by cars in this area so the committee is drafting an email to Facilities Management to see what we can do about this. The committee also talked about the Mental Health & Wellbeing Model and thinks it might be good to endorse it and be proactive on it— if that is something Exec wants to take to Forum, it might be cool. Rosemark had meeting with Matt Hoekstra in Disability Resource Center (DRC) and they need more support because more and more students are going to Counseling and getting referred to DRC and there's not enough support for these students; Matt is currently only DRC staff member and has to rely on The Office of Academic Success.

Brichacek- To go off of that, MCSA used to pass a lot of resolutions and I would like to see more of that. Keep that in mind, in association with your role, which resolutions you could write that would have a positive impact on campus, a resolution does not need to be major.

Brown- We have gotten into our minds that resolutions need to be giant things after we did the one for the polling place but it would be cool to more resolutions because they would still make an impact. Resolutions go to Campus Assembly and if they are approved, they have to be adopted as official UMM policy.
