Provost Imholte announced some changes in the agenda. Number V, a proposed constitutional amendment should be deleted. In addition to the two faculty members that need to be elected to the Consultative Committee, one more faculty member is to be elected to fill the one-year term vacated by David Hoppe. Valerie Olness should be added to the list of seniors graduating with distinction. Student names added as members of the Academic Grievance Committee are Carolyn Donlin, Brad Holman, Jill Klinger, and Corey Redfield, in addition to Dan Brophy as alternate.

The minutes of the May 3 Assembly were approved by voice vote.

The Continuing Education and Summer Session segment of the proposal from the Curriculum Committee was approved by voice vote. The proposed change in the General Education Requirement was introduced, i.e., Psychology 3600, Quantitative Methods in Psychology to be included as an option under Part 1, E.1 of the GER. Psych 3600 will have no prerequisite listed as of next year. Debate over the proposal focused upon the appropriateness of the offering for the GER as an upperdivision course apparently treating applied mathematics. The split vote and issues of the Curriculum Committee were reviewed. The motion carried by a show of hands, 25 pro, 23 con, 6 abstentions.

The names of students graduating "With Distinction" for spring and summer, 1982, were approved by voice vote. Concern was expressed that the size of the list suggested a review of the criteria for this award be carried out next year by the Functions and Awards Committee. The Scholar of the College nominees were approved as designated by the Functions and Awards Committee.
