- Minutes approved
- Noelle: We have vacancies. Bri is no longer exec assistant. Public Relations Officer also needs to be filled. There are also campus assembly rep positions open.
- Spring Semester Goals presentation
- Dylan: We got 47 respondents to our activities fair survey.

We will have a diversity, equity, and inclusion audit. We will look over our hiring practices and make recommendations to improve equity and diversity.

- Student services: Conduct student worker survey. Implement student legal services free. Organize two food odyssey events, explore food insecurity issues facing students who stay in Morris over breaks. Advocate for cookware available for checkout in dorms.
- Legal services fee: TC and Duluth have these fees. Students pay around \$20-25 and receive legal counseling. Legal issues that can be covered range widely
- R&O: Tech fee, advocate for birth control vending machine, advocate for CPAC, advocate for meditation spaces, create yearly audit of campus accessibility.
- CPAC: Emphasizes shared governance and democratic ideals.
- External affairs: Campaign for investment in Morris infrastructure, accessibility, tuition waiver. <u>See ppt</u> again they are talking very fast and the speech is essentially what is on the slides.
- Noelle highlighted a few issues from our spring semester goals spreadsheet.
- Green bin idea: essentially, reducing waste by sharing things between student orgs?
