The title of Lieberman's lecture is "Beyond Perception." This event, which is free and open to the public, is sponsored by the Campus Activities Council (CAC) Convocations Committee.

A modern renaissance man, Lieberman explores connections between the arts, sciences, education, passion, creativity, and the potential future of human consciousness. He also shows technological and perceptual sculpture around the world, sharing an emotional and mystical connection with science and the universe.
