#1 Welcome and announcements

Student Allie Jutton is joining for the first time.

#2 Minutes from October 6, 2022

Zoom poll to approve minutes from Meeting #4 - October 6, 2022. Motion made by B. Deane, seconded by Chasman. Minutes were approved (10-0-0).

#3 Catalog changes - Education

Motion from Education to approve catalog changes from Education. Seconded by Franco. One new course proposed (Teacher and Learning Community) to connect new students to Education. Changes to courses are due to state terminology changes. Two deactivations. Change in prerequisites for ED 2121. Ng asked if ED 1104 is open to all students and if education students are given priority; Page responded that any student can take it. Flinn commented that all changes fit in assessment. Motion approved (11-0-0).

Motion from Education to approve catalog changes from Elementary Education. Seconded by J. Deane. Two proposed new courses: ELED 4108 and 4109. Program needs to meet state requirements about arts in the classroom. Many name changes to match terminology. Also removed outdated prerequisite information. Terminology shift will take time to become consistent. Motion approved (10-0-0).

Motion from Education to approve catalog changes from Secondary Education. Seconded by Johnson. More terminology changes and changes to match licensure areas. Theater option added back; it was removed from the catalog accidentally. Added NAIS 1101 as a required course for Social Studies licensure. It does not increase the credit load. Motion approved (11-0-0).

Motion from Education to approve catalog changes from Sport Studies and Athletics (SSA) and Sport Management. Seconded by Panda. Added a new Sport Law course. Minor revisions to many courses. Restructuring to prerequisite structure for many of the courses. To gain more rigor in the capstone course, reducing content and moving it to the Sport Law course. Ng asked about the connection between the Sport Law course and the capstone. Page said that it is not meant to be a capstone course, but it helps the capstone be more vigorous by not needing to also cover that material. The change was prompted by colleagues on the Twin Cities campus. B. Deane asked about the expertise level we can offer to the sport law course. Page suggested she is open to a name change to not

suggest expertise. She will pull that course and bring it back to a future meeting. Franco made a motion and Chasman seconded to pull SSA 3104 from the motion. Motion approved (10-0-0). Panda commented that Management supports Sports and Event Marketing. Motion as amended approved (11-0-0).

IS and Honor courses need division level approval before coming to the Curriculum Committee on November 17. Ng asked if we can remove the November 3 meeting. No objections.
