Call Issued for Proposed Papers for 1977 Annual Meeting

A first call has been issued for papers to be considered for presentation at the 1977 annual meeting of the Minnesota Academy of Science, April 29 - 30 at St. Cloud. Individuals wishing to submit papers must make a preliminary contact before March 3, 1977, with designated chairpersons for the different sections, whose names are listed below. This initial notice should include the title of the paper and an indication of time needed for the presentation and any special equipment such as a projector or blackboard that may be required.

Papers offered for presentation at the meeting also may be submitted for possible publication in the Academy Journal.

Academy membership is not necessary for submission of material to the Journal, but space limitations and the publication's desire to include reports of research and investigations from several disciplines enforce a certain amount of selection, in which case Academy members may be given priority. In this context it is worth mentioning that the 1976 annual meeting, held jointly with the North Dakota Academy of Science, attracted more than 250 papers. The Journal can publish only a fraction of that number, even with the expanded frequency of publication that is now planned.

Academy members or researchers may suggest discussion sections for the annual meeting that are not presently programmed and may do so by contacting the Academy office.
