Linda Keller '13 takes seventh at NCAA Division III Women's Cross-Country Championship Meet

Summary: The two-time All-American set a new school record.

(November 21, 2011)-The times keep dropping and the accolades keep coming for Cougar cross-country runner Linda Keller, Hawick, who again broke her own record in earning her second straight All-America honor on November 19 at the 2011 NCAA Division III Women's Cross Country Championship meet.

Keller placed seventh with a 21:07.60, the best finish of her career. The time drops 10 seconds off her school record, which she set with a 21:17.70 on October 15 this season.

She was just two seconds out of a top five finish and was less than 30 seconds behind champion Chiara Del Piccolo from Williams who stopped the clock in 20:52.08.

Keller ran in the top-10 for the entire race and climbed as high as fourth at the three-mile mark before finishing in seventh.

The best finish at the NCAA meet in her career, she is now a two-time All-American, winning the honor for the first time last season after a 19th place finish.
