Chancellor Johnson to deliver keynote address at Faculty Leadership in Sustainability workshop

Summary: The workshop will explore the responsibility of informing and inspiring cultures of permanence.

(March 11, 2011)-Chancellor Jacqueline Johnson will be a keynote speaker at the Faculty Leadership in Sustainability: A Midwest Regional Workshop to be held on March 23–24, 2011, at the University of Wisconsin, River Falls.
