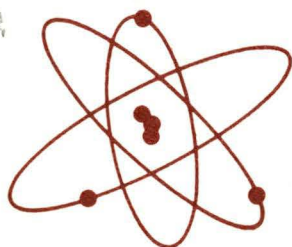

The 27th Annual Meeting of the Minnesota Academy of Science was held on May 1 and 2, 1959, at Bethel College in St. Paul.
