The public is invited to a Community Coffee with President Bruininks from 7:30 to 8:30 a.m. Thursday, Oct. 11, at the Common Cup Coffeehouse in downtown Morris.

In addition to their meeting agenda, regents will meet UMM students, faculty and staff and tour the campus.

The 12-member Board of Regents is the governing body of the University of Minnesota. The legislature elects one regent from each of Minnesota's eight congressional districts and four from the state at large.

One of the four at-large regents must be a University student at the time of election. Regents serve without pay for six-year terms. The president of the University is ex officio president of the Board. The Board meets monthly (except for January and August) on the second Friday and the preceding Thursday. Although regents meetings are open to the public, they have pre-set agendas and visitors will not be invited or allowed to speak.
