**Juried Student Art Exhibition**

*Summary: Work by both art and non-art majors will be on view during the 2007 Juried Student Art Exhibition in the Gallery of Humanities Fine Arts at the University of Minnesota, Morris.*

(February 27, 2007)-Work by both art and non-art majors will be on view during the 2007 Juried Student Art Exhibition in the Gallery of Humanities Fine Arts at the University of Minnesota, Morris. An opening public reception will be held at 7 p.m. Thursday, March 22. The show runs March 22-April 14.

In addition to a rich variety of two-dimensional works, such as drawings, paintings, photos and prints, the exhibition will also include exquisite mixed-media works, and ceramic pieces.

For the second time in the history of this annual student exhibit an outside juror was brought in to jury the work for the show. The juror chosen this year was Wanda Schackmann-Flechsig '79. She is also the founding director of the Circa Gallery in Minneapolis and a UMM alumna. During her time at UMM, she studied art history and studio art. Circa Gallery was founded in 1990 and continues to present mature, varied, well-crafted artwork by some of the nation's most respected artists. Circa's mission is to provide awareness, discernment and appreciation of a vast array of contemporary styles, media and expressions.

Schackmann-Flechsig selected 36 pieces out of the 93 pieces entered into the show, making this student show one of the most competitive exhibits in current years.

Gallery hours are 9 a.m.-8 p.m. Monday-Thursday 9 a.m.-6 p.m., Friday 1-5 p.m., Saturday.
