UMM students will be decorating their residence halls in fine Homecoming fashion all day on Thursday, Sept. 21.

The UMM Alumni Association Annual Banquet will be held on Friday, Sept. 22, beginning with a 5:30 p.m. reception in Oyate Hall, followed by a 6 p.m. dinner. Jon Mukand '80 and Stu Starner '65 will be honored as UMM's 2006 Distinguished Alumni Award recipients. Jim Gremmels, professor emeritus of English and UMM's first men's basketball coach and current coach, will be inducted into the Cougar Hall of Fame.

A Pepfest, followed by a bonfire will begin at 8 p.m. Friday in the P.E. Center gym, followed by the Black Student Union dance in Oyate Hall.

Also on Saturday, the traditional Homecoming Parade will begin at 11:30 a.m. Stand or sit along the parade route which proceeds from the campus to Columbia Avenue to Seventh Street to Atlantic Avenue to Second Street and then to the UMM P.E.
