**Selections from the UMM Permanent Collection open HFA Gallery season**

*Summary:*

(August 24, 2005)-Selections from the Permanent Art Collection at the University of Minnesota, Morris are on display through September 9 in the Humanities Fine Arts Gallery. The display opens the Gallery's 2005-2006 exhibition season.

Most of the works in the collection are traditionally displayed in public campus spaces, such as administrative offices, the Student Center, or the Humanities Fine Arts corridors. Acquisitions for the collection began in 1961 and now number over 300 original works of art in virtually every medium. Some works in the collection have been gifts from individuals or given to the University by artists who have exhibited their work in the Gallery.

The public is invited to view the exhibit through September 9. There will be no opening reception.
