Summary:

(June 15, 2005)-West Central School of Agriculture (WCSA) alumni will celebrate the school's 95th anniversary during their annual reunion July 16 at the University of Minnesota, Morris. Anyone who attended, worked, or taught at the School of Agriculture from 1910-1963 is invited to attend.

Registration begins at 10 a.m. Saturday in the UMM Student Center. The reunion will also include campus walking tours, a brunch, the annual Alumni Association Business Meeting and an evening banquet. Attendees will have the opportunity to sign up for a deluxe coach ride and guided tour of the West Central Research and Outreach Center, Horticulture Gardens, and energy-generating wind turbine.

In 1909, the University of Minnesota established the WCSA high school on the site of what is now the Morris campus, a nationally recognized public liberal arts campus of the University. WCSA offered classes in home economics, business, industrial arts, and agriculture. WCSA was an education center for western Minnesota providing workshops and educational programs for members of the community and region.
