Brion Dalager Memorial Scholarship awarded to UMM musicians

Summary:

(April 18, 2005)-Four University of Minnesota, Morris music students are recipients of the Brion Dalager Memorial Scholarship, given annually by Morris residents Vincent and Joyce Dalager. This is the 30th annual award, presented in honor of the late Brion Dalager, a UMM music student from 1969 to 1972.

Student recipients are Lacey Heald, Ogilvie Terri Jo Schuft, Stewart Joel Adams, Fergus Falls and Dustin Retzlaff, Morris.

The scholarship is awarded annually to students who have demonstrated outstanding ability on a band instrument. Students received recognition following the April 17 UMM Concert Band performance.
