First-ever swim meet set for October 29

Summary:

(October 26, 2004)-For the first time in school history, the University of Minnesota, Morris pool will be used for a collegiate meet as the Cougar women's swimming and diving team hosts MSU-Moorhead this Friday, Oct. 29. The meet begins at 6 p.m. at the UMM pool in the P.E. Center.

Head Coach David Molesworth said, "I am really excited to be in this position where we are starting a program. I think we have some great potential on our team and the team has already surpassed my expectations in certain areas. This group of women has already put in a lot of time and effort doing something that some of them have not done in 4-5 year (competitive swimming). All teams have to start somewhere, and for us October 29 is that place.

We are having a lot of fun getting to know each other and I know that this season holds some wonderful things for all of the ladies on the team. I would encourage anyone who has the chance to come and watch this team take its first step."

Molesworth has a roster of 16 athletes, three of whom are divers.

This will be the only home meet of the 2004-2005 season for the Cougars. They will head to St. Paul on Saturday, Nov. 6, in a triangular at the College of St. Catherine with Augsburg beginning at 1 p.m.
