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**Master of Education available at UMM**

*Summary:*

(July 26, 2004)-The University of Minnesota, Morris, will host a Master of Education program offered by the University of Minnesota - Duluth's College of Education and Human Service Professions, beginning in the fall of 2004 on the Morris campus.

The M.Ed. program offers professional development for those in education or human service professions: classroom teachers, educators in specialized areas, and professionals with training responsibilities in higher education, health sciences, social services, and community education as well as business and industry. A teaching license or education degree is not required for the M.Ed. degree.

The 30 credit Master's program is delivered in a cohort, with 20-25 professionals moving through common or core courses as a group in a blended course format. On-line instruction will replace some of the traditional face-to-face classes in the M.Ed. program, allowing students from rural Minnesota and surrounding states to continue full time employment while completing the degree. The entire program can be completed in 2-3 years of part-time study. Applications for the Fall 2004 M.Ed. Morris cohort will be accepted through Friday, July 30.
