UMM Concert Band, Wind groups to tour

Summary:

(April 13, 2004)-The University of Minnesota, Morris Concert Band, Symphonic Wind Ensemble, and Chamber Winds, under the direction of Dr. John Stanley Ross, will tour Minnesota from April 22-24. Collaborative concerts will be performed with students at high schools in Morris, Litchfield, Paynesville, Wayzata, and Stillwater. The conclusion of the tour will be a performance on the UMM campus in the Recital Hall of Humanities Fine Arts at 3 p.m. Sunday, April 25.

This spring performance will feature three different ensembles, three concertos performed by UMM students, and three works conducted by students. Also featured will be two multi-media works during which dancers and visual artists will spontaneously create art as the band performs. The audience will also have the opportunity to share in their own creation of art in a special way, so this is a concert you will not want to miss. Tickets, available at the door, are \$3 for general admission, and \$1 for students and seniors.
