Gallery exhibit: American Watercolor Society

Summary:

(September 8, 2003)-The American Watercolor Society was founded in 1866, the same year that Venice became a part of Italy. The Society's Traveling Show, consisting of 40 paintings executed by artists from all corners of the United States, is the next exhibit September 20 - October 31 in the Gallery of Humanities Fine Arts at the University of Minnesota, Morris. The public opening reception will be held from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. on Saturday, Sept. 20, in the HFA Gallery.

HFA Gallery hours are Monday-Thursday, 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. Friday, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.. and Saturday, 1 to 5 p.m. Gallery exhibitions are free and open to the public.

Paintings were selected from 102 paintings chosen from this year's New York exhibition. These 102 paintings were originally selected from 1,700 slides submitted to an elected jury.

The AWS boasts among its past and present members celebrated artists Winslow Homer, Georgia O'Keefe, and Andrew Wyeth, to name a few.
