For the first time since joining the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference three years ago, the University of Minnesota, Morris men's and women's basketball teams will both compete in the UMAC post-season tournaments on February 24 and 25.

For the Cougar women, it is their first-ever post-season tournament berth. They finished the regular season 16-9 overall and 10-4 in the conference, and will be the number three seed in the tournament to be played at Presentation College in Aberdeen, S.D.

Under first-year Head Coach Randi Peterson, the women will meet number two seed Northwestern College at 5:30 p.m. Friday, Feb. 24, at the Strode Center on the campus of Presentation College. Number one seed Presentation College will take on Martin Luther College, the number four seed, in the second game at 7:30 p.m.

The two winners will meet in the post-season championship game at 5 p.m. Saturday at Presentation College.

The defending UMAC post-season tournament champion Cougar men's team will travel to Duluth for the men's post-season tournament at St. Scholastica, also February 24-25.

The Cougar men, under Head Coach Paul Grove, are 13-12 overall and 8-6 in the conference and will be the number four seed to play the host and number one seed St. Scholastica Saints. Tipoff is set for 7:30 p.m. Friday, Feb. 24.

Northwestern College, the number two seed, will meet third-seeded Bethany Lutheran in the first game Friday. Game time is at 5:30 p.m.

The men's championship game will be played at 7 p.m. Saturday at the College of St. Scholastica Reif Recreation Center.

Tickets can be purchased at the game sites.
