McNally hits 1,000 point milestone

Summary: Brendan McNally '07, Lindstrom, garners 1,000 career point as Cougar basketball athlete.

(February 14, 2006)-Cougar athlete Brendan McNally '07, Lindstrom, needed just four points heading into the February 10, 2006, basketball game against Martin Luther College in New Ulm to reach the 1,000 point mark in his career at the University of Minnesota, Morris. McNally hit the milestone with 16:19 remaining in the first half by making a pair of free throws to give him 1,001 points.

“We are very proud of Brendan for scoring 1,000 career points,” stated Paul Grove, head men’s basketball coach at UMM. “This is a great accomplishment for anyone, but Brendan has done it in his junior year. He has his entire senior year to climb his way up the ladder of all time leading scorers in the history of Cougar basketball. Brendan is more than just our leading scorer. He also leads the Cougars in rebounding and blocked shots as well.”

McNally finished the evening’s competition with a game high 24 points leading the Cougars to an 88-65 win.
