**Campus contributes to holiday projects**

*Summary: Nearly \$1,800 worth of toys was collected during the Toys for Tots drive, and seven families benefitted during this year's Adopt-a-Family, thanks to campus students, staff and faculty at UMM.*

(December 20, 2005)-Nearly \$1,800 worth of toys was collected during this year's Toys for Tots drive by campus students, staff and faculty at the University of Minnesota, Morris.

"Once again, campus donors and volunteers came forward to try to make Christmas a little more special for children who might otherwise have gone without a gift," said Carol McCannon, Coordinator for Community Service and Volunteerism at UMM.

The campus partnered with Stevens County Social Services to distribute the toys to families in Stevens County.

In addition, seven families in Stevens County were adopted by UMM offices and organizations during the Adopt-A-Family holiday program. Campus participants in the program included the women's soccer and basketball teams, E-Quality, Blakely Hall, Pine Hall, United Latinos, Office of Residential Life, and the Office of Student Activities.
