Morris to Celebrate 8th Annual MLK Day of Service

All are invited to take part in service projects, a march, program, and community meal.

MORRIS, Minnesota (January 3, 2017)—The University of Minnesota, Morris will celebrate the 8th annual Martin Luther King Jr. Day of Service on Monday, January 16. People of all ages and abilities are invited to join in this Day of Service, which includes service projects as well as a march, program, community meal, and facilitated conversations about hopes for the Morris community.

Volunteers can take part in one of three service projects: preparing a Morris Community Meal, leading lessons about the Civil Rights Movement at Morris Area Elementary School, or discussing shared hopes for Stevens County. [Preregistration for these projects](#) is required.

Everyone is invited to gather at East Side Park for a public march to Faith Lutheran Church (108 West 8th Street, Morris, MN 56267) at 4:15 p.m., in honor of King's dedication to equality for all. A program will begin at 5 p.m., with a free community meal at 5:30. Free transportation back to East Side Park and the Morris campus will be provided after the meal.

This year Lazos, Morris Area PFLAG, and the Morris Human Rights Commission are co-sponsoring a speech or essay contest for students in grades 7–12 who reside or attend school in Stevens County. A panel of community leaders will judge the entries and award three cash prizes and the opportunity to share the speech or essay with participants in the day of service.
