She has become increasingly engaged both in intercultural pedagogy and educational technology, seeing each field as central to teaching our increasingly diverse student population. From the start of her teaching career Mongan-Rallis has been an early adopter of emerging technologies and has led the way in her department and on the UMD campus in piloting new technology initiatives. She teaches courses to undergraduate and graduate students on topics related to teaching with technology and online, hybrid, and flipped teaching. She also is engaged in research, faculty development, and a variety of service work in the areas of educational technology, intercultural pedagogy, and intercultural leadership development.
