### **Drewe Jefferson '16 Earns Fulbright Award**

- Drewe Jefferson '16 earned a Fulbright U.S. Student Program award for 2019–20.
- A German and English grad, Jefferson will spend nine months teaching English in Germany before pursuing graduate study.
- Eight UMN Morris students submitted Fulbright applications this year, and five were semifinalists.

Drewe Jefferson '16 earned a Fulbright U.S. Student Program award for 2019–20. A German and English grad, Jefferson will spend nine months teaching English in Germany.

Jefferson earned an English Teaching Assistant (ETA) award, which will place her in a classroom abroad to provide assistance to local English teachers. She also will represent the United States as a cultural ambassador during her time overseas.

Jefferson hopes to take in all that Germany has to offer. In addition to teaching, she plans to join a local hiking organization to learn about traditional German herbal medicine.

"The Fulbright experience sounded right up my alley, as I majored in English and minored in German," she says. "I felt firsthand experience in a different culture would open up my perspectives on the world and enrich my language and teaching abilities."

## The Journey There

Jefferson says the small class sizes and close-knit community at UMN Morris set her up for success in the Fulbright competition. That environment, along with mentoring from the campus's award-winning faculty, prepared Jefferson for the thorough application process.

"UMN Morris offers a unique learning environment," she says. "When I started the application process, I had all the tools at my fingertips, and I felt comfortable asking questions when they would arise."

#### The Road Ahead

When it comes to the future, Jefferson intends to pursue graduate study and a career in higher education. She trusts her Fulbright year will help her get there.

"This experience will expand my perspectives and knowledge as I prepare to attend graduate school to be trained as an instructor and academic in literature and the language arts."
