ACTIVITY PROGRAM

The University of Minnesota, Morris, will have a broad activity program the first year, it has been announced by Acting Dean Rodney A. Briggs. Freshman classes start at Morris this fall.

There will be a full year's social calendar including dances and other activities each quarter. The first year will be climaxed by a campus-wide activity day in the spring.

Other activities in the Morris program include a strong intramural schedule of football, basketball and softball, as well as individual swimming and track events. The formation of a student council, student newspaper, dramatic society, chorus and service clubs are also part of the plan.

"The major emphasis of the University of Minnesota, Morris, remains education," stated Dean Briggs, "but extra-curricular activities must be planned to develop well-rounded students to fit their role in society ^{following} ~~upon~~ college graduation".
