FIRST YEAR COURSE OFFERINGS ANNOUNCED AT UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA, MORRIS

Courses have been designed to fulfill the requirements of the first year offering of Science, Literature and Arts, as well as the prerequisites of many professional schools. The courses already approved are:

English - Freshman English and Remedial English for those who require it.

Social Sciences - World History and Civilization, Political Science, Economics and Sociology.

Mathematics and Science - A full year's course offering in Mathematics to meet the needs of the incoming freshman student will include courses in college level Algebra, Calculus and Analytical Geometry. A student without full high school preparation would have his needs met by one or the other remedial courses in Math that would also be offered.

A full year of Freshman Chemistry, Physics and Biology will be offered.

Two languages, French and Spanish, will be offered for the incoming freshmen to select from.

Other courses - The freshman student may also select courses in Related Arts, Music and Physical Education.

The aim of the Morris Campus Advisory Committee has been to maintain the high standards of the University of Minnesota and meet the needs of college students in West Central Minnesota. Special consideration was given to course offerings that would prepare students for entrance with professional schools.
