COLLEGE ENTRANCE TESTS FOR PAST GRADUATES AVAILABLE (NEEDED ?)

Students planning to attend college next fall should take the American College Tests which will be given from 9 to 12 a.m. on February 27, 1960. This includes students that have graduated from high school in previous years as well as this year's seniors. Students that are now out of school should contact their local high school principal before February 5 to make application for this test.

Testing centers that will be administering these tests on February 27 that may interest students of West Central Minnesota, will be the University of Minnesota, Morris; Alexandria High School; Fergus Falls High School; Little Falls High School; Redwood Falls High School; and the Willmar High School.

"With college courses starting September 26 at the University of Minnesota, Morris, it is believed a sizeable group will want to take this test", states Dean Rodney A. Briggs.
