#### GRADUATE COURSE OFFERED AT UMM

A special course in guidance procedures for high school faculty members will be offered at the University of Minnesota, Morris beginning in February. Dean Rodney A. Briggs announced today. The 3-credit course is Educational Curriculum and Instruction (Edci) 135: Group Procedures in Guidance.

Classes will meet every Monday from 4:15 to 6:45 p.m. beginning February 27. They will continue through May 8, omitting March 27 during Holy Week. Instructor will be Thomas Soldahl of the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis Campus.

Those guidance procedures which are most effectively carried out with groups of people will be emphasized in the 10-week course. Attention will be given to such topics as the guidance function of classroom teachers, orientation procedures, homeroom guidance activities, units or courses in occupations or personal adjustment, guidance through co-curricular activities, career or college days, and socio-drama.

People interested in enrolling in this evening class should write to the Office of Student Services at the University of Minnesota, Morris. A minimum enrollment is necessary.
