A well-known and popular speaker who has frequently addressed Morris groups, the Reverend Paul Hanson of Willmar, will appear at the University of Minnesota, Morris convocation at 11:30 a.m. Wednesday in Edson Hall.

The public is invited to attend this convocation which is a highlight of the UMM's first Religious Emphasis Week. The special week will also include a "Clergy Day" on Thursday at which Rev. Hanson will address the clergy of the Morris area.

Well-qualified for his role in UMM's Religious Emphasis Week, Rev. Hanson received a Bachelor of Science degree from South Dakota State College, Brookings, a Bachelor of Arts degree from St. Olaf College, Northfield, and a Bachelor of Theology degree from Luther Seminary in St. Paul. He also attended Biblical and Union seminaries in New York City and Princeton Theological Seminary, Princeton, New Jersey.

Rev. Hanson was formerly pastor of the air parish in South Dakota, ministered to a widespread congregations reached by plane. He then served as pastor in Lemon, South Dakota before moving to Willmar where he has been at Vinje Lutheran Church for the past several years.
