AGGIE CAGERS WIN 2 IN WEEK-END SERIES

The Morris Aggies came out on top in week-end games as they defeated Tintah on Friday nite and the Brookings Aggies on Saturday evening in a preliminary to the UMM vs. Wahpeton game.

On Friday night the Aggies fought back from a 9 - 1 deficit in the 1st period to trail 15-9 at the end of that period. In the second period the Aggies outscored the Tintah team 10-8 but were still behind 19-23. The third quarter found the Aggies connecting on 7 field goals and 3 free throws for 17 points while holding their opponents to 11 points as they took the lead 36-34.

In the final period the Tintah team went to a press to regain the lead but were unable to contain the Aggies who scored 15 to lead 52-42 at the end of the game. Jim Alhsten of Tintah was high scorer with 18 and was followed by Mathias of the Aggies with 17.
