Twelve University of Minnesota, Morris students comprising the Inter-Faith Council, together with the Council of Religious Advisors, have planned the program for the University of Minnesota, Morris's first Religious Emphasis Week now in progress.

The Inter-Faith Council is composed of two representatives from each of the six campus religious foundations. Members include: Gamma Delta representatives, Janet Pomerence and Keith Wendt; Inter-Denominational Christian Fellowship, Ronald Jorgenson and Bernadine Lundberg; Lutheran Collegiates, Judith Bogie and Ronald Larson, who are the Council secretary and treasurer, respectively; Lutheran Student Association, Susan Hendricks, Council vice president and Richard Munson; Newman Club, Janet Lawler and Theodore Storck; United Protestant Campus Fellowship, Judy Stoner, Council president, and Lenora Wells.

Morris church leaders who make up the Council of Religious Advisors are Rev. Carl Wirth, Rev. Harold Reemtsma, Rev. R. H. Roth, Mr. Rollen Halvorson, Fr. Robert C. Landsberger, and Rev. George F. Hartz.

Program for the week includes a special "Clergy Day" on Thursday, February 9 when between 50 and 60 clergy from communities within 50 miles of Morris are expected to attend meetings and discussions on the UMM campus. After a welcome by Dean Rodney A. Briggs at 1:30 p.m., the group will be addressed by Rev. Paul Hanson, pastor of Vinje Lutheran Church in Willmar, and John Q. Imholte, lecturer in history and political science at UMM.

Meetings with the campus religious foundations and a tour of the campus will conclude the day's activities.

Rev. Hanson will also speak at the UMM convocation at 11:30 on Wednesday, February 8 at Edson Hall.
