The prospect of launching a college career at the age of 61 has a retired Morris postman eagerly awaiting the March 27 start of spring quarter classes at the University of Minnesota, Morris.

E. P. Sherven, one of the most recent UMM enrollees, was employed by the Post Office in Morris for more than 42 years before his retirement January 6, 1961. After 29 years as a regular clerk, he was a city carrier until 1952 when he began covering Rural Route 3. He delivered mail on this route until his retirement.

Mr. Sherven is registered this spring in two sociology courses, "Man in Modern Society" and "Social Problems" and an American history course covering the middle and late nineteenth century.
