Winner of three Academy Awards, "All the King's Men" will be shown at 8:30 p.m. on Monday, March 27 to subscribers of the University of Minnesota, Morris film series. It will be exhibited in Edson Hall auditorium on the UMM campus.

Based on the Pulitzer Prize novel by Robert Penn Warren, the picture stars Broderick Crawford, Mercedes McCambridge and John Ireland. The film was also the recipient of the New York Film Critics Award.

A dynamic portrayal of a demagogue, the story traces the rise to power of a state governor. Robert Rossen, who produced, directed and wrote the screenplay, has succeeded in depicting the screen character of Willie Stark as a man of high ideals, but subject to overpowering egotism and ruthless corruption.

The film is the third in the UMM series.
