MUSIC DEPARTMENT AT UMM TO GIVE CONCERT TONIGHT

Tickets are still available for the special concert of the Department of Music of the University of Minnesota, Morris at 8:30 p.m. tonight (Tuesday) in Edson Hall auditorium.

HOLDERS of University Artist Course tickets who were unable to attend last Tuesday's concert may use their tickets tonight. Admission for the general public is 75 cents for adults and 50 cents for students and may be paid at the door.

Ballet music, a minuet, two excerpts from Tchaikowsky's Sixth Symphony and Mozart's "Fantasie" will be played by the new University Symphony Orchestra to open tonight's concert.

The 44-piece orchestra will be followed on the program by the string ensemble playing selections from Handel, Schubert, and Brahms.

The mixed chorus and men's chorus will each present four numbers covering a wide range of types and periods of music from sixteenth century to the present and from spirituals to popular numbers.

The selections by the UMM band which will conclude the program will span music from the seventeenth century to a recently published rhumba selection.

All UMM music groups are under the direction of Ralph E. Williams, assistant professor of music.
