### SILENT CLASSIC TO CONCLUDE U FILM SERIES

The most famous of Russian films, "Potemkin", will conclude the first University of Minnesota, Morris film series. The Russian silent film, directed by Sergei Eisenstein, will be shown at 8:30 p.m. Monday, May 22 in Edson Hall auditorium on the UMM campus.

Climaxing an exciting and varied film series, "Potemkin" depicts the famous mutiny of the sailors aboard the battleship Potemkin during the abortive revolution of 1905. Made in 1925, "Potemkin" has had vast influence on subsequent film-making.

Shown with the movie will be three short subjects including 1922 newsreels, a 1923 excerpt of a comedy of Red Army Life, and a studio re-enactment of the Potemkin mutiny, filmed in Paris in 1906.
