#### Canadian Farm Business Association Stops Over at University Campus

Seventy-one members of the Carman District Farm Business Association stopped overnight at the UMM Campus on Thursday, June 29. This farm management district is located in the Province of Manitoba and was organized in cooperation with the University of Manitoba, Winnipeg, Canada. Mr. J. P. Hudson, Research Associate, University of Manitoba, has served as arrangements chairman for the Minnesota tour.

While at the Morris Campus the group participated in a steak fry in the picnic area Thursday evening and there proceeded to tour the ARS facility, as arranged by Dr. Robert Holt and Associates. On Friday morning following a breakfast meeting, a tour was held of the West Central Experiment Station activities. Details of the tour were handled by the Experiment Station personnel.

The group was met in Morris by Truman Nodland, Professor of Agricultural economics and Hal Routhe, Extension Farm Management Specialist both of the University of Minnesota, St. Paul. They will accompany these two bus loads of Canadian Farm Business members to the vicinity of Worthington, Minnesota. The Carman District members will be guests of the Southwest Minnesota Farm Managers Association and will tour farms of interest in that area.

The group will leave Worthington Sunday morning, July 2 and will lunch at the UMM Dining Hall enroute to Winnipeg.
